Brush Up Your Bridge Summer 2024.

Saturday 8th June – Saturday 10th August. 10.30am – 12.30pm

This 10 weeks course is aimed at anyone who has attended our courses in the past or stopped playing bridge during the pandemic. It will help to revise some key ideas from the Acol System as well as helping to update bidding and play. The aim of the sessions is to help people update their skills and to develop playing duplicate bridge in a supportive environment.

These sessions will cost £5 each which will be paid weekly. Participants can choose which sessions they attend, there is no need to sign up to all of them. Those non-members who attend 6 sessions will be offered complimentary club membership to the end of the Club Year.

After the course has ended (Sessions 11 onwards) participants will be supported to play, defend and score in duplicate bridge. The aim of these sessions will be to prepare participants for playing in a more competitive game. Simple duplicate sessions will run where 12+ boards are played in a supported but competitive session. These sessions will be supported by club members. The cost for each session will be £5.
